



Urban Public Health (UPH) BS

- UPH students must complete all General Education and Core Curriculum requirements and enough general elective courses to reach a minimum of 120 credits before graduation.
 - General Education Requirements: 36 credits. UPH Core Curriculum: 42 credits. General Electives: 42 credits
 - Undergraduate UPH students must meet with their Academic Advisor each semester.
- UPH students must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- All PUBHTH courses must be passed with a C- or better, and cannot be taken on a pass/fail basis. A grade of C- or below in any of the core courses is considered failing, and the course must be repeated.
