

Graduate Withdrawal Checklist

Before you withdraw:

Discuss your decision!

We are here to help. If needed, make an appointment with one or more of the below support services to discuss your decision to withdraw or transfer. We want you to have all the information and options in front of you before making the decision to withdraw or leave.

Discuss your decision. Graduate students must consult with your [Graduate Program Director](#) Graduate students are subject to a [Statute of Limitations](#) & must maintain continuous registration, so should complete the Leave of Absence Request Form in order to extend their timeline and be placed on Program Fee for the duration of their leave.

Understand the financial consequences of withdrawing. Check the [Bursar website](#) for Student Refund schedule. Please note that after 5 weeks into the semester, no refunds will be granted.

Did you get Financial Aid? Withdrawing may result in a reduction to the financial aid disbursed to your semester bill and may affect your future UMass Boston financial aid eligibility for students who are not maintaining [Satisfactory Academic Progress](#). Review your Account Activity. Check WISER to see if you have an outstanding balance. Outstanding or overdue balances will prevent the release of records such as transcripts and may impact your ability to re-enroll.

Do you have the University Health Insurance? Insured students who withdraw from school after the 31st day following the first date of eligibility of the policy period will remain enrolled in the qualified Student Health Insurance Plan for the full period for which the premium was paid.
